- The level of technical training you have obtained to date (attach transcripts / mark records).
- Please provide letters of reference / recommendation from at least two people (e.g. teachers, employer, community leader).
- List award achievements and volunteer activities / involvements.
- Tell us about your interest in the industry and why you chose this career path.
- How you plan to be involved in the industry in the future.
